I. Project Summary (1-2 Paragraphs)

• Total Amount Requested \$20,390.84 (\$7,621.84 if only partial funding is available)

a) Silver Project: \$19,163 (\$6,394 if only partial funding is available)

b) Bronze project: \$1,227.84

• Give a brief general description of how the funds will be used. Troop 23032 has girls taking on two community projects to earn their Bronze and Silver Awards. The Bronze, Silver, and Gold Awards are the highest awards a Girl Scout can earn. Each award gives Girl Scouts the chance to make their communities and the world a better place while learning essential leadership skills along the way. Highest Award projects can be as unique as the Girl Scouts completing them, and there is no limit to what a Girl Scout can achieve with these exceptional projects!
Juniors, ages 8-11, earn the Bronze Award by teaming up with other girls to make a difference in their towns. Cadettes, ages 11-14, earn the Silver Award by researching an issue, making a plan to address it, and then taking action to improve their communities.

- a. **Bronze project:** The bronze project scouts will work with the Gustavus Public Library's administrative director, Melisa Gomb. The scouts have already met with Melisa and described their project. The will be providing three different types of STEM (science, technology, engineering, math) kit; sewing machine, pressure canning, and needle felting. The scouts were able to show Melisa examples of the STEM kits they will be giving to the library and have received approval to move forward. Ms. Gomb taught them about the basics of putting together a STEM kit from the aspect of cataloging it. The scouts will meet with Ms. Gomb at crucial points throughout the project.
- b. **Silver project**: The Silver Project, cadette scouts realized that the recently re-opened Rookery did not have outdoor play equipment for the children who attend the facility. The cadettes reached out to Kelly McLaughlin, a Rookery representative to pitch their idea. The Rookery board has given the girl scouts approval to begin this project. During the meeting with Ms. McLaughlin the scouts learned that the Rookery is interested in having alternative outdoor play structures. The goal is to encourage the children attending the rookery to explore, play and learn in the outdoor

environment. The girls will meet with another Rookery representative in December to work on mapping out the outdoor spaces for use. The Girl Scouts will research all items and will not be purchased until approved by the Rookery. This one is in part to make sure the structure fits with the vision of the organization as well as to make sure that the organization's insurance policy will cover them.

 - a) Liesl Barker had served as a Troop leader and bronze advisor with Troop 78 through Girl Scouts of the Chesapeake Bay when they completed their bronze award project in 2022-2023, building and installing a Gaga ball pit for a county park in Delaware.
 - **b)** Liesl Barker has assembled learning kits for libraries, assisted with grant writing and administrative grant duties, created training and orientation materials, etc.
 - c) Girl Scout Cadettes Loralei Barker and Marie Proctor will be working on completing their Silver Award project. Girl Scout Juniors Telsani Bishop and Liesabet Barker will be working on completing their bronze award project. All four of these Girl Scouts have learned and practiced budgeting, goal setting, organization, bookkeeping, and interpersonal skills through running multiple fundraisers throughout their years as Girl Scouts. Combined, these Girl Scouts have 18 years of experience. Liesabet and Loralei have prior experience completing/participating in higher awards-level projects. Loralei earned her bronze award with Troop 78, and Liesabet was a bronze award support scout who helped her Troop 78 with every step of the project in which they purchased and built a Gaga ball pit in a local park.
- Partnerships and relationships with other key organizations or people involved with the project: GSAK has been active in Alaska for 70 years. The council's role and purpose are to help support and guide Troops within the

council territory, which spans from Bethel to Ketichikan. While Troop 23032 will plan, work, and implement their projects, GSAK will be there for them if they need advice or assistance.

a) As mentioned in the project summary section, the girls will be working closely with the Rookery Learning Center on the playground equipment and with the Gustavus Public Library's administrative director, Melisa Gomb.

III. Project Description (1-2 pages)

- Problem Statement describe the need of the project, including supporting documentation
 - a) Bronze: The junior Girl Scouts both enjoy the library and use the STEM kits one can check out. They realized the library did not have a sewing machine, pressure cooker, or needle felting kits that patrons could check out. Living in a remote area, it is important to be able to make or fix clothing or other household linen items and to be able to preserve food by pressure canning to help provide greater food stability throughout the year. They chose the needle-feeling kits because they thought it was an activity that most people, typically ages 8+, can enjoy together, and it's also often a stress-reducing activity.
 - b) Silver: The Cadette Girl Scouts realized that the recently re-opened Rookery has no outdoor play structures for the kids who attend the facility.
- **Community Benefit** describe how the project will benefit Gustavus and its citizens. Who will it serve?
 - a) Bronze: The bronze project has the chance to benefit the entire community. The library is a free resource provided to the residents and visitors to Gustavus. A library card is the only requirement for a person to check out a STEM kit. The targeted age group of these kits is 8 years and older. The sewing and needle felting kits will appeal to the widest age ranges. According to the 2022 census, 99% of the population in Gustavus is 10 years and older. (Census Reporter, n.d.) The pressure canner's target age range is 18+; according to the 2022 census data, about 84% of Gustavians are 20 years and older. (Census Reporter, n.d.)
 - b) Silver: The silver project will benefit all the families who use Rookery currently and in the future. Currently, the Rookery serves approximately 8-9 children regularly. They also provide after-school events/activities for school-age children after school hours. In the next year, they expect the number of

children regularly being served to double with the recent baby boom here in Gustavus. It is important for the children attending the rookery to have safe play structures that encourage learning through play, being outdoors, and socialization opportunities.

- **IV. Link to City's goals -**Does this project tie into the City's defined goals as stated in the strategic plan? How?
 - Vison A Goal 4: Promote key aesthetic values, such as the presence of wildlife; cleanness and beauty of beaches, roadsides and facilities; views of the night sky; and quiet (Strategic Planning Committee, 2005, p.55)
 - a) Silver Project: The alternative outdoor play structures will enhance the use of the wooded area near the rookery building and preserve the natural appeal of the roadside.
 - Vison B Goal 4: Support quality schooling for youth that develops excellent thinking and social skills (Strategic Planning Committee, 2005, p.57)
 - a) Silver: Cadette scouts would like to provide an outdoor learning through play experience for the Rookery Learning Center by providing alternative play structures. According to Children's Hospital of Philadelphia studies have shown that learning through play outdoors improves concentration, mood, sleep at night and help children grow socially. (Philadelphia, n.d.)
 - Vision B Goal 6: Provide opportunities and activities that prepare youth for life outside of Gustavus while encouraging appreciation of the natural and social environment here (Strategic Planning Committee, 2005, p.57)
 - a) Bronze: By providing sewing machines and pressure canners, the Girl Scouts will be encouraging the youth of Gustavus and all individuals to learn hands-on skills that they can use anywhere. Learning how to pressure can items, in particular, is a great way to take advantage of all subsistence living opportunities and help them last all year round. One could catch halibut or salmon and learn how to pressure can their catch of the day to be able to store shelf-stable fish all year round. In Gustavus, the berry collection is a popular activity; it would be great for the community members to have the opportunity to make jams and pie fillings all year. Part of the scout's project is not only to provide the items but also to have easily accessible YouTube videos with instructions for the items.
 - b) Silver: By providing an alternative play structure to the Rookery Gustavus's children will have the opportunity to foster a love and

respect for the outdoors from a very young age. Having these experiences during their prime developmental year will open them up to more opportunities later in their educational journey.

- Vision B Goal 7: Support the volunteer organizations that provide needed community services. (Strategic Planning Committee, 2005, p.57)
 - a) Bronze: Although the Gustavus Public Library is part of the city, the majority of its day-to-day tasks are completed by a wonderful group of volunteers. The Gustavus Public Library also relies heavily on grant monies to help provide library materials. The Girl Scouts will be able to provide 3 new STEM (science, technology, engineering, math) kits to help further the expanse of the library material while meeting community needs.
 - Silver: The Rookery Learning Center is meeting a community need since no preschool or other childcare is currently offered anywhere in the city.
- Vision B Goal 10: Maintain subsistence as an important component of our economy and Lifestyle (Strategic Planning Committee, 2005, p.57)
 - a) Bronze: Learning how to pressure can and water bath can is an important part of the subsistence lifestyle. Taking one's foraged, hunted, or caught items and making them shelf-stable to last throughout the year is an important skill for living in remote areas. Having pressure caners available at the public library for use by people in the community would help individuals who are not able to afford a canner to pressure can food, thus providing a greater level of food security throughout the year.
- Vision D Goal 4: Support social, educational and recreational events and activities for the entire community (Strategic Planning Committee, 2005, p.59)
 - a) Bronze: This project will provide 3 different types of stem kits to the library for anyone and everyone in the community to use. The Girl Scouts put a lot of time into thinking about 3 kits that people of all ages could enjoy. They have chosen to provide a needle felting kit with enough supplies to last over 1 year of use. The second stem kit will be a sewing machine with basic thread, bobbins, scissors, pins, a stitch ripper, and a rolling sewing case. The Girl Scouts wanted this case to be on wheels in case someone had trouble carrying items when walking. The final stem kit will be a pressure canner with all the basic supplies, such as a funnel, tongs, jar lifter, etc. Along with this project, the scouts will be making basic instructional videos on how to get started with several other links to tips and tricks, projects, or recipes. The videos will

- be easily accessible through a QR code that will take them to the YouTube video.
- b) Silver: With the recent baby boom in Gustavus there will be great need in the next year for the children 0yrs-12yrs to have safe, fun, creative ways to explore and learn about our ecosystem. Through alternative outdoor play structures, it will encourage the children of Gustavus to be one with nature while learning social skills, math, science, etc. all through play.
- **Concluding Statement-** Summarize why this project should receive funding and why now. Have you demonstrated that you have the ability to effectively manage the project?
 - a) Bronze The girls want to complete this higher awards project now because Liesabet will be moving up to cadette next year, so she only has this year to complete it. By completing the STEM kits this spring, patrons will be able to check out them this summer. This will be perfect timing for the pressure canning kits since they are the most seasonally used STEM kit.
 - b) Silver—The goal of this project is to be completed for the 2025-26 school year. Rookery Learning Center is planning on having an increased number of children attend each year. The sooner the silver higher award project can be completed, the sooner the children attending the Rookery will have age-appropriate play structures. These will help build the children's love of the outdoors while fostering learning experiences through play and exploration.
